**What is God Saying To Us?**

**1. We Need To Impact Our Community**

**Acts 1:8** But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

**2. We Must Raise Up Disciples**

**2 Timothy 3:1-4** But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty. For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant...disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, heartless...without self-control, brutal, not loving good...swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God.

**Luke 21:36** But **stay awake** at all times, **praying** that you may have **strength to escape** all these things that are going to take place, and to stand before the Son of Man."

**Matthew 4:18-20** As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." At once they left their nets and followed him.

**3. We Need to Strengthen Ourselves For The Expansion**

**2 Samuel 7:1-3** After the king was settled in his palace and the LORD had given him rest from all his enemies around him, he said to Nathan the prophet, "Here I am, living in a house of cedar, while the ark of God remains in a tent." Nathan replied to the king, "Whatever you have in mind, go ahead and do it, for the LORD is with you."

**1 Chronicle 22:2-5** So David gave orders to assemble the foreigners residing in Israel, and from among them he appointed stonecutters to prepare dressed stone for building the house of God. He provided a large amount of iron to make nails for the doors of the gateways and for the fittings, and more bronze than could be weighed. He also provided more cedar logs than could be counted, for the Sidonians and Tyrians had brought large numbers of them to David. David said, "My son Solomon is young and inexperienced, and the house to be built for the LORD should be of great magnificence and fame and splendor in the sight of all the nations. Therefore I will make preparations for it." So David made extensive preparations before his death.
