It is our earnest desire that you participate with us by encouraging your child to learn the Scriptures! We know God will draw your family closer to Him as you study together!


Getting Started

Swordsmen's Club Weekly Verses

Verses are assigned weekly for children and parents to work on together! These verses must be recited on the dates listed in the following pages to receive credit! (See schedule on pages 3 - 6). If you are going to be absent, you can make up the verse up to one week late.

Children who recite weekly verses will earn \$20 Kids Point Bucks! If parents also recite the weekly verse, children will earn an additional \$10 Kids Point Bucks!

Children will earn \$30 Kids Point Bucks for every completed Bonus Passage.



A note to Parents:

We are so excited that your family has joined this awesome challenge! When your child is trying to memorize big chunks of Scripture, start with the first verse and add on each week until your child can say the entire passage!

For example, on 1/8 learn Ephesians 6:10-11.

On 1/15, on recite Ephesians 6:10–12. Each week, add a new verse to the one previously learned! We hope this helps you as your family hides God's Word in your hearts!

Reciting 4 Bonus Passages earns a Silver Medal! | Reciting 6 Bonus Passages earns a Gold medal! All Bonus Passages must be completed by April 23, 2023.



ELITE Super Swordmen's Challenge

5th graders also have the option of participating in the Elite Super Swordsmen's Challenge! The ELITE Challenge requires 5th graders to memorize not only the weekly verses and the 6 Bonus Passages, but to also memorize an additional 6 Elite Passages (see page 10).

They can recite the passages any time during the year - whenever they feel ready! We recommend that 5th graders complete at least 1-2 passages a month to finish the ELITE Challenge on time!

5th graders who complete the ELITE challenge will be honored with a special medal at our Medal Ceremony in the Main Sanctuary!

They will also receive an invitation to our Super Secret Party!

They must complete all required Bonus and Elite Passages by Sunday, April 2023. 5th graders will earn \$30 Kids Point Bucks for every completed ELITE passage.

Tips For Memorizing Scripture:

- Set aside time every day for Bible memory.
- Read the verse aloud several times a day.
- Be sure you DEFINE words and help your kids understand the meaning behind every single verse they memorize.
- Make the verse a song or add hand motions.
- Have the kids write down the verse on paper!
- Review the verses you learn regularly. This will help make sure your kids really use the verses to impact their lives.
